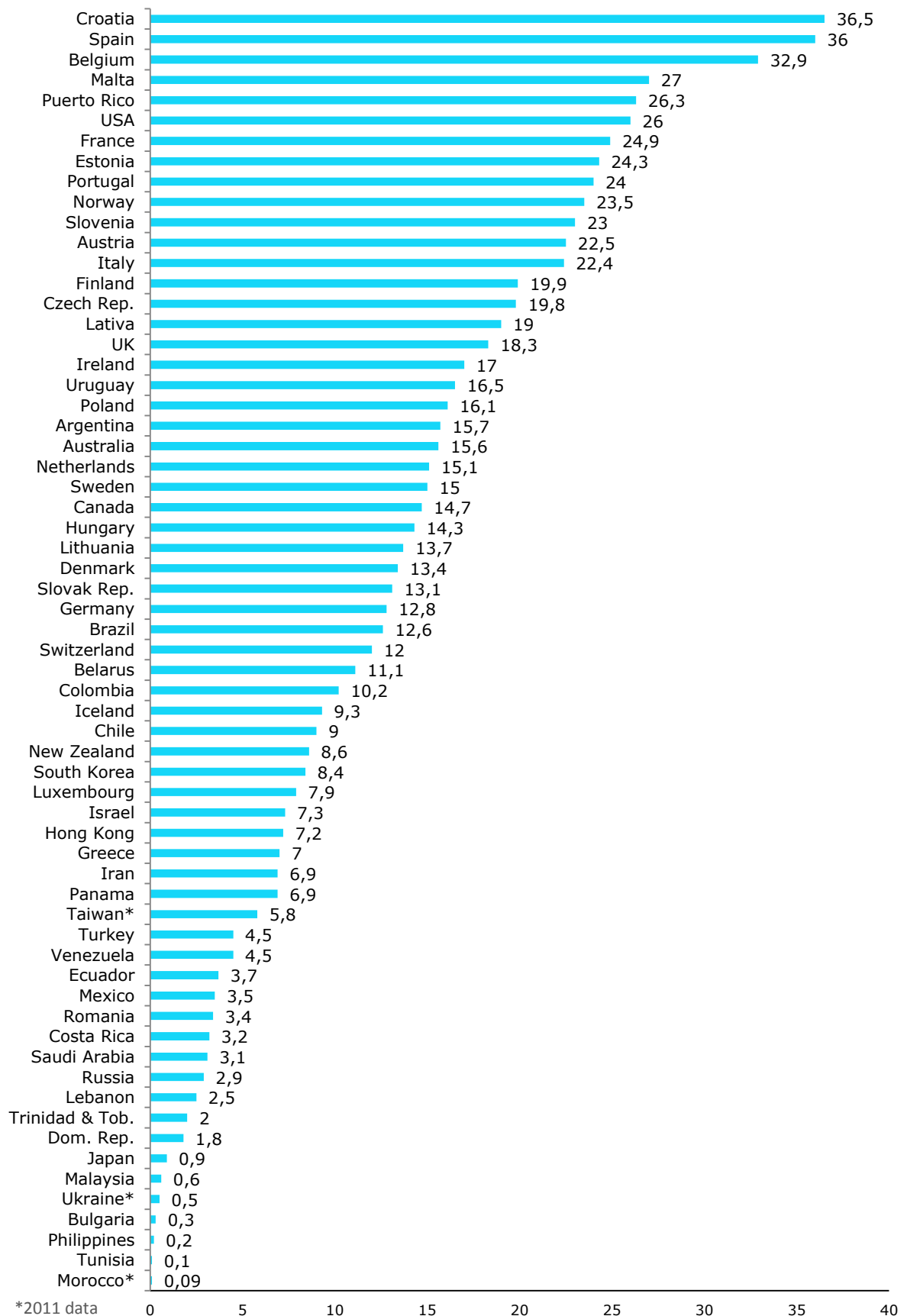

1. WORLDWIDE DONATION ACTIVITY

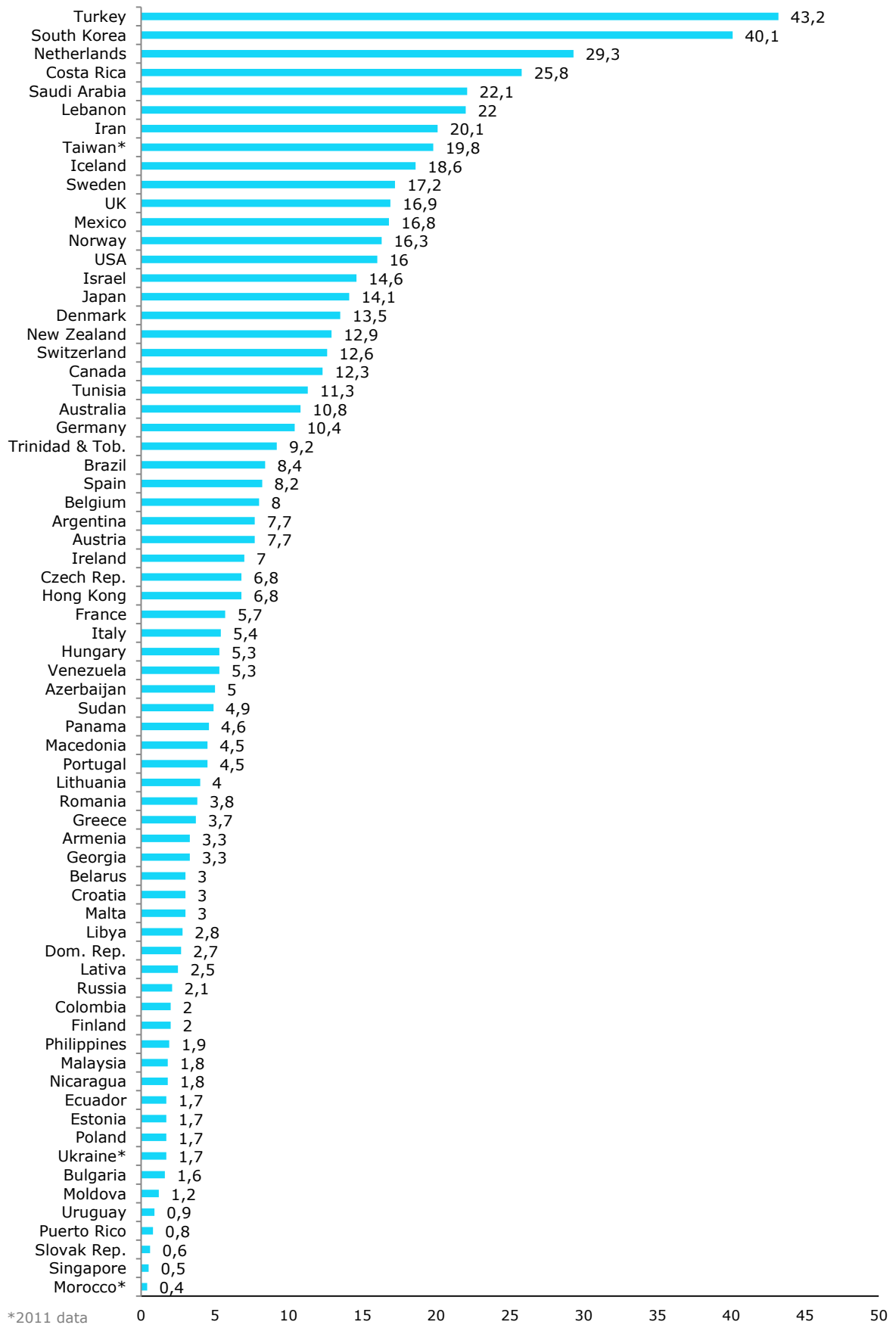

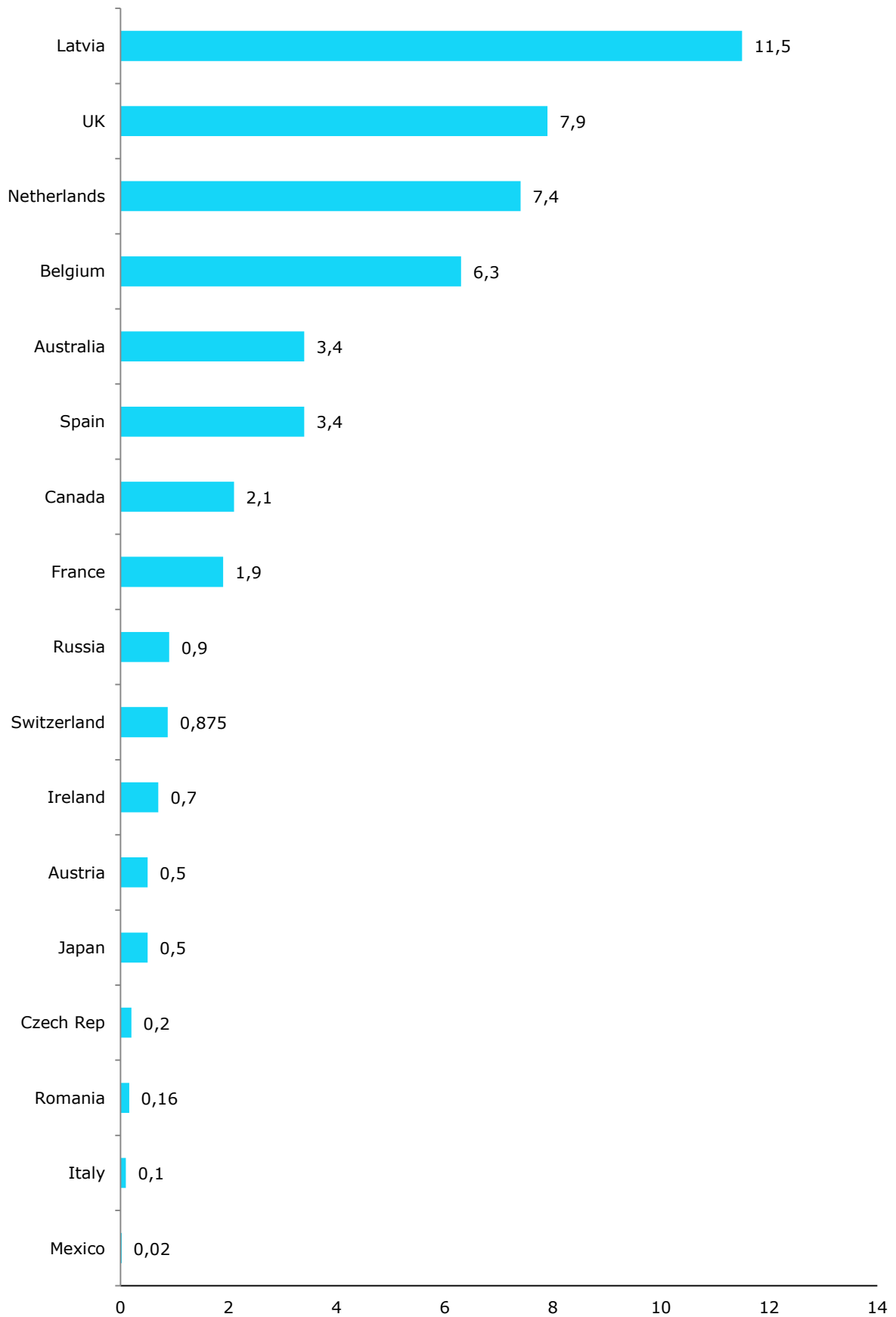
Worldwide Actual Deceased Organ Donors (pmp)



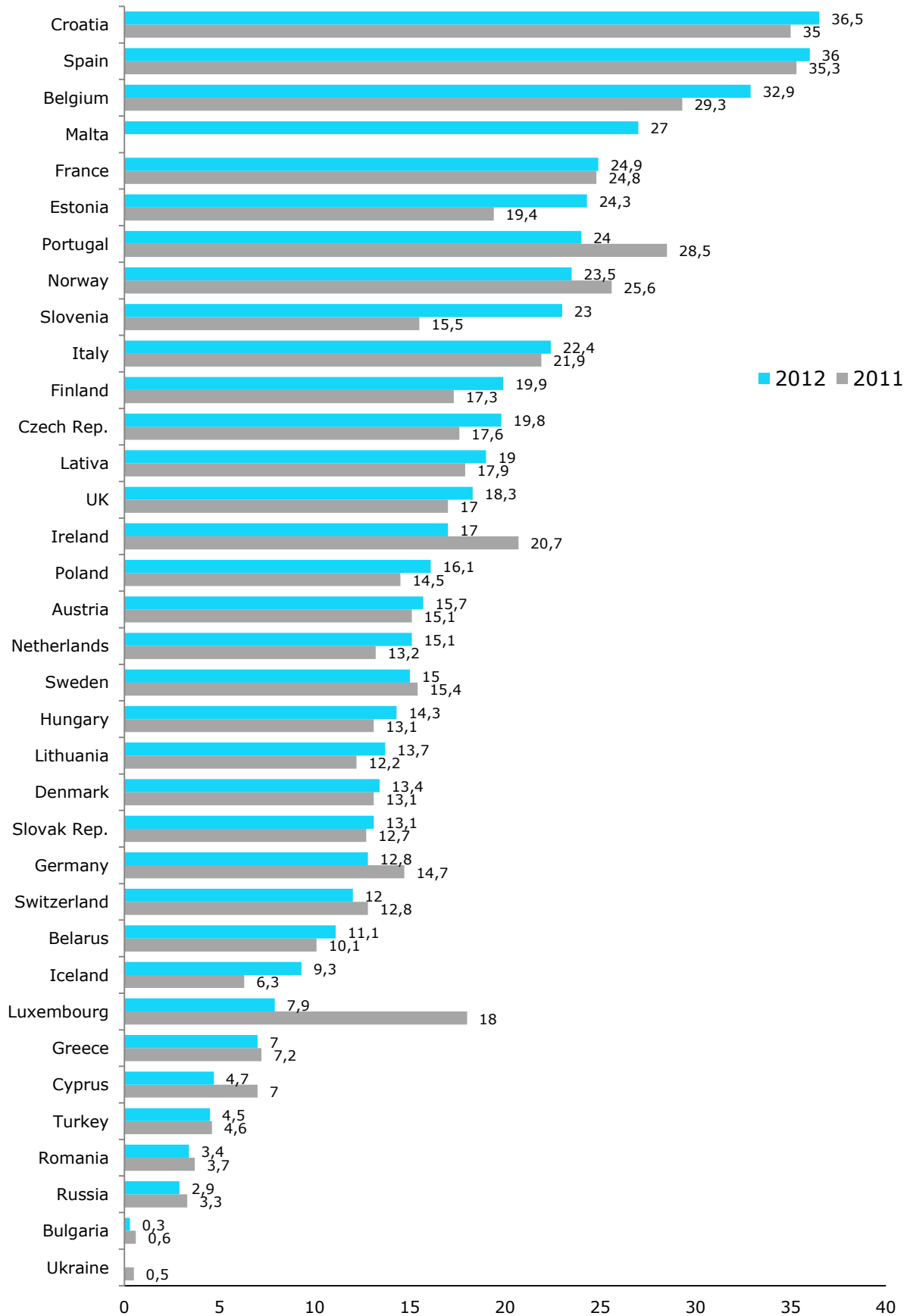
Worldwide Living Organ Donors (pmp)



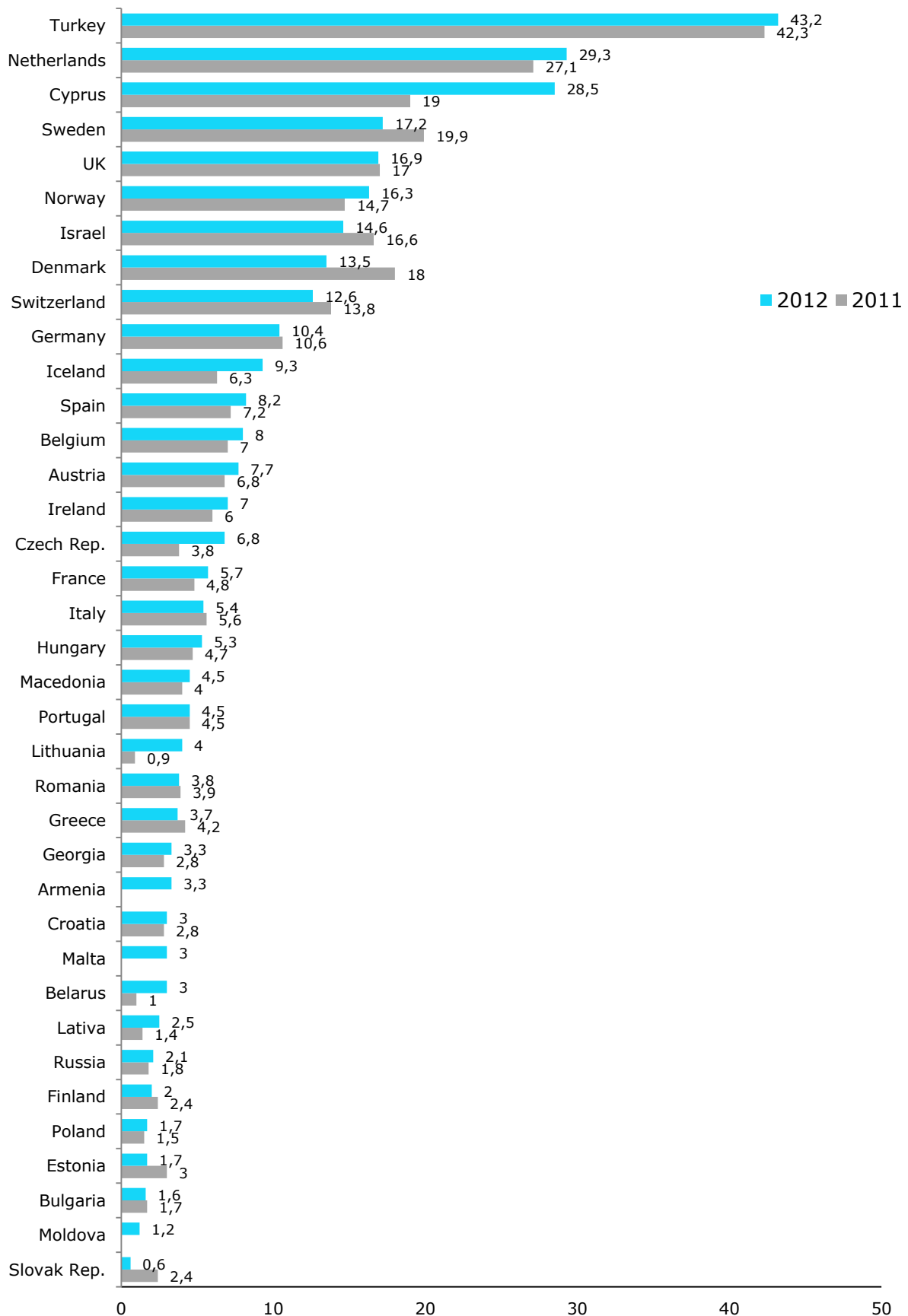
Donors After Cardiac Death -DCD- (pmp)



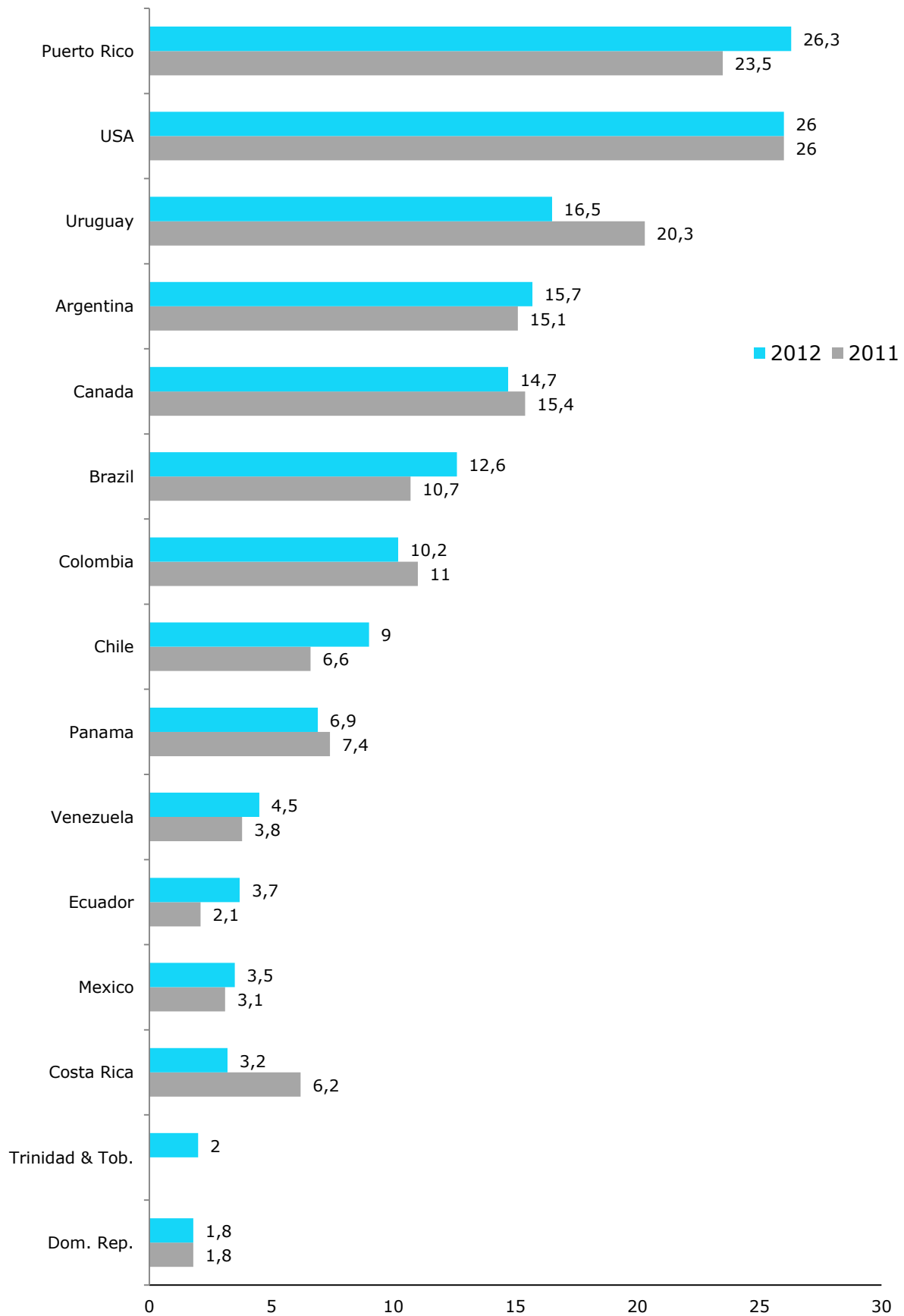
Europe Actual Deceased Organ Donors (pmp)



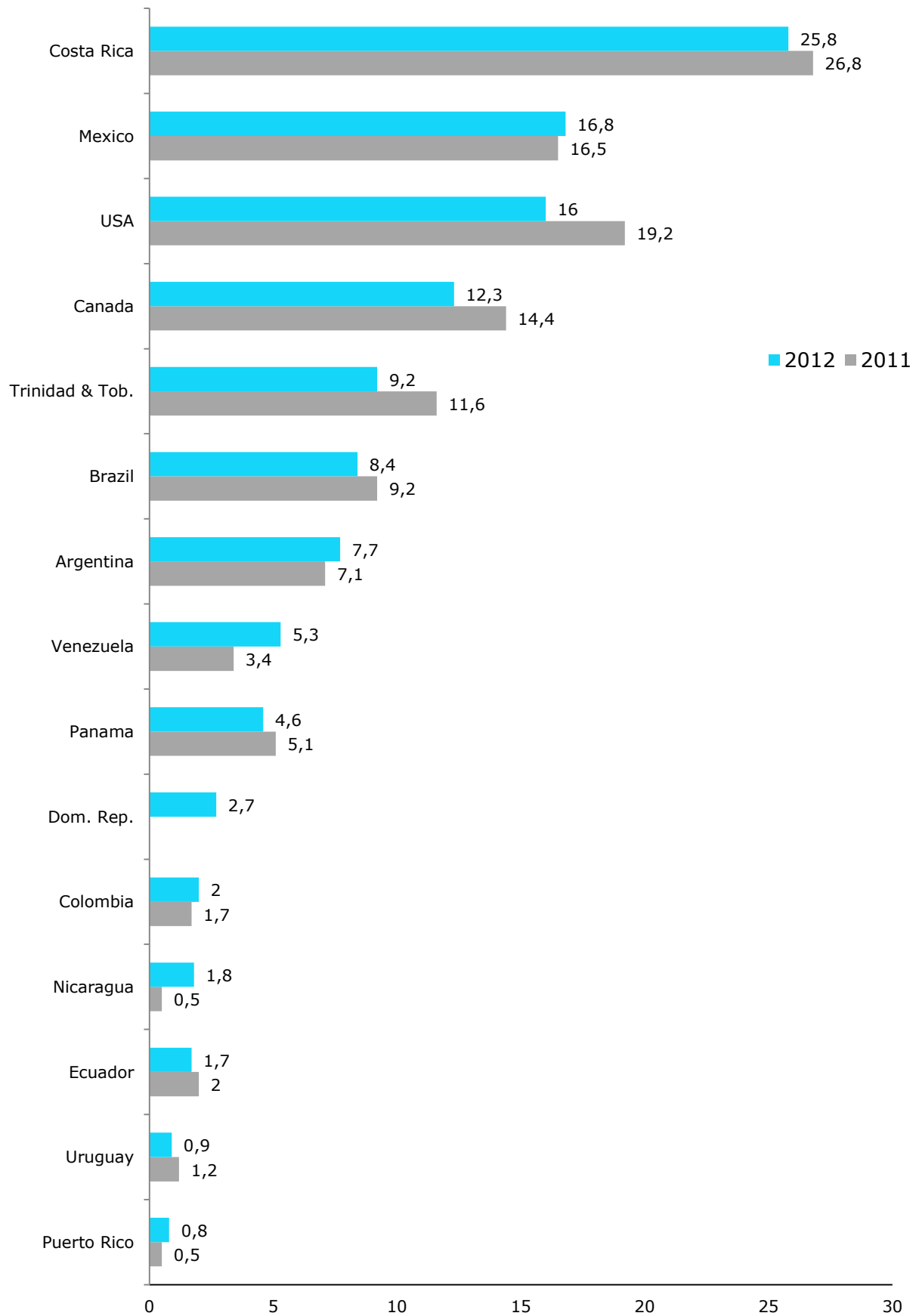
Europe Living Organ Donors (pmp)



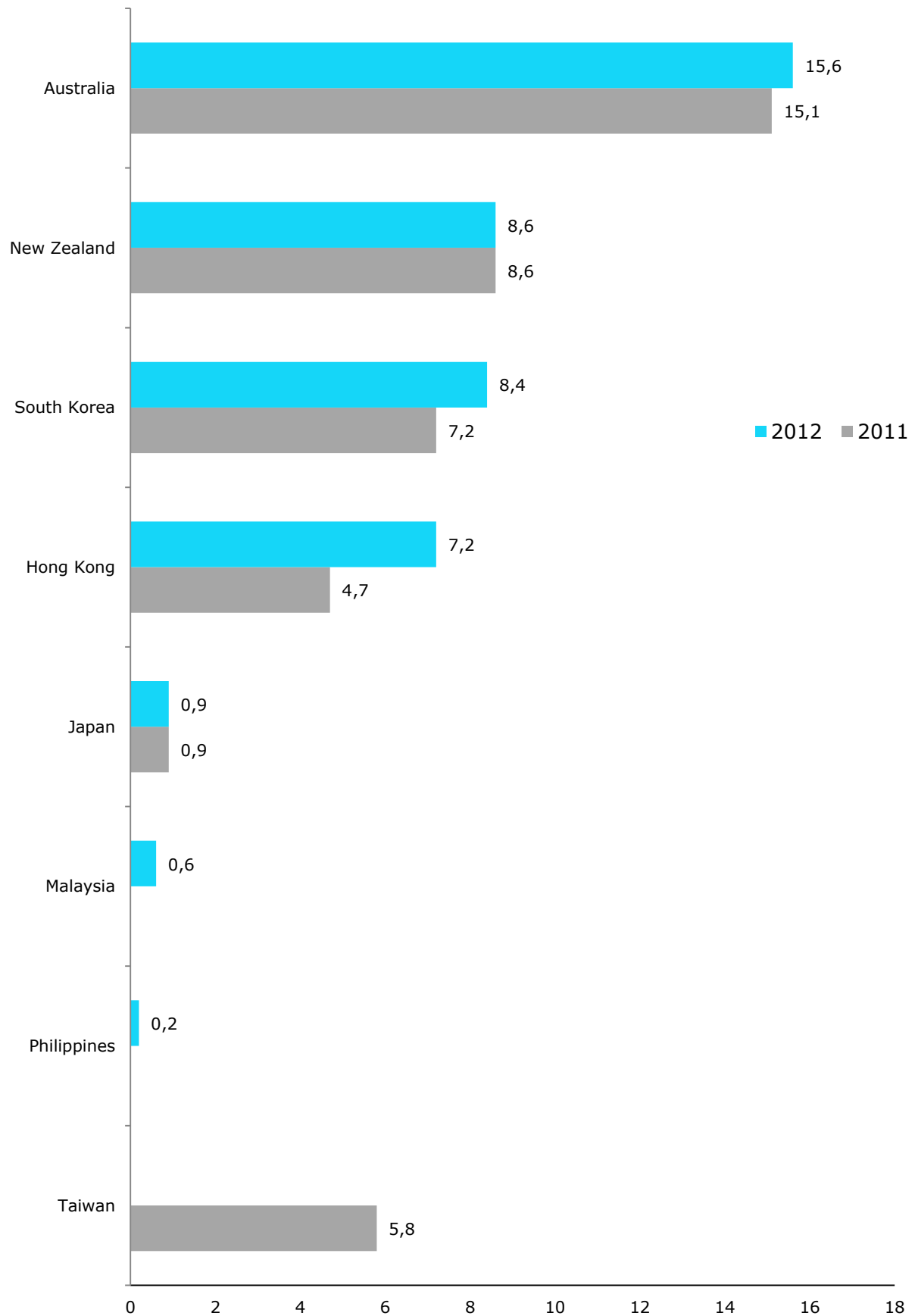
America Actual Deceased Organ Donors (pmp)



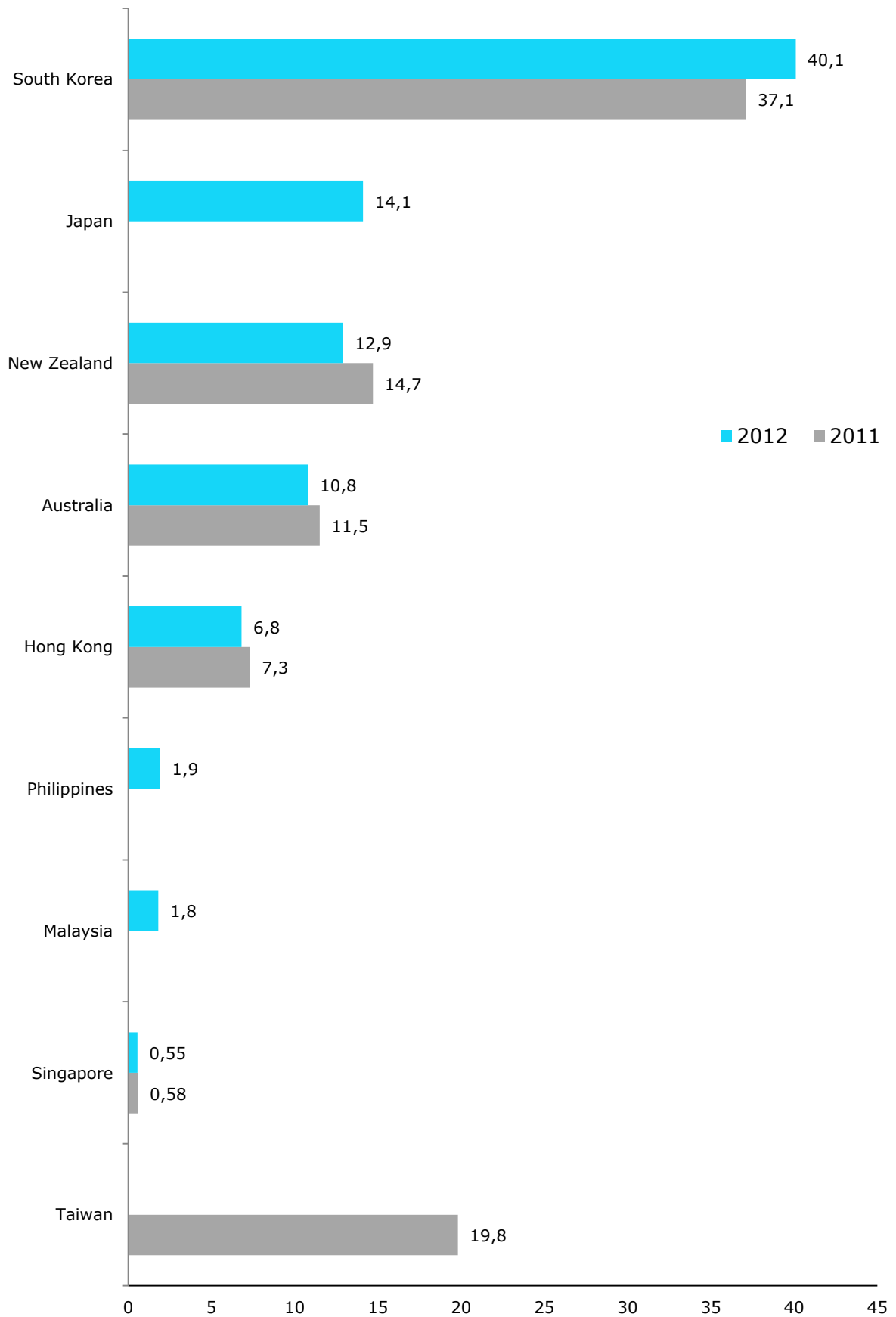
America Living Organ Donors (pmp)



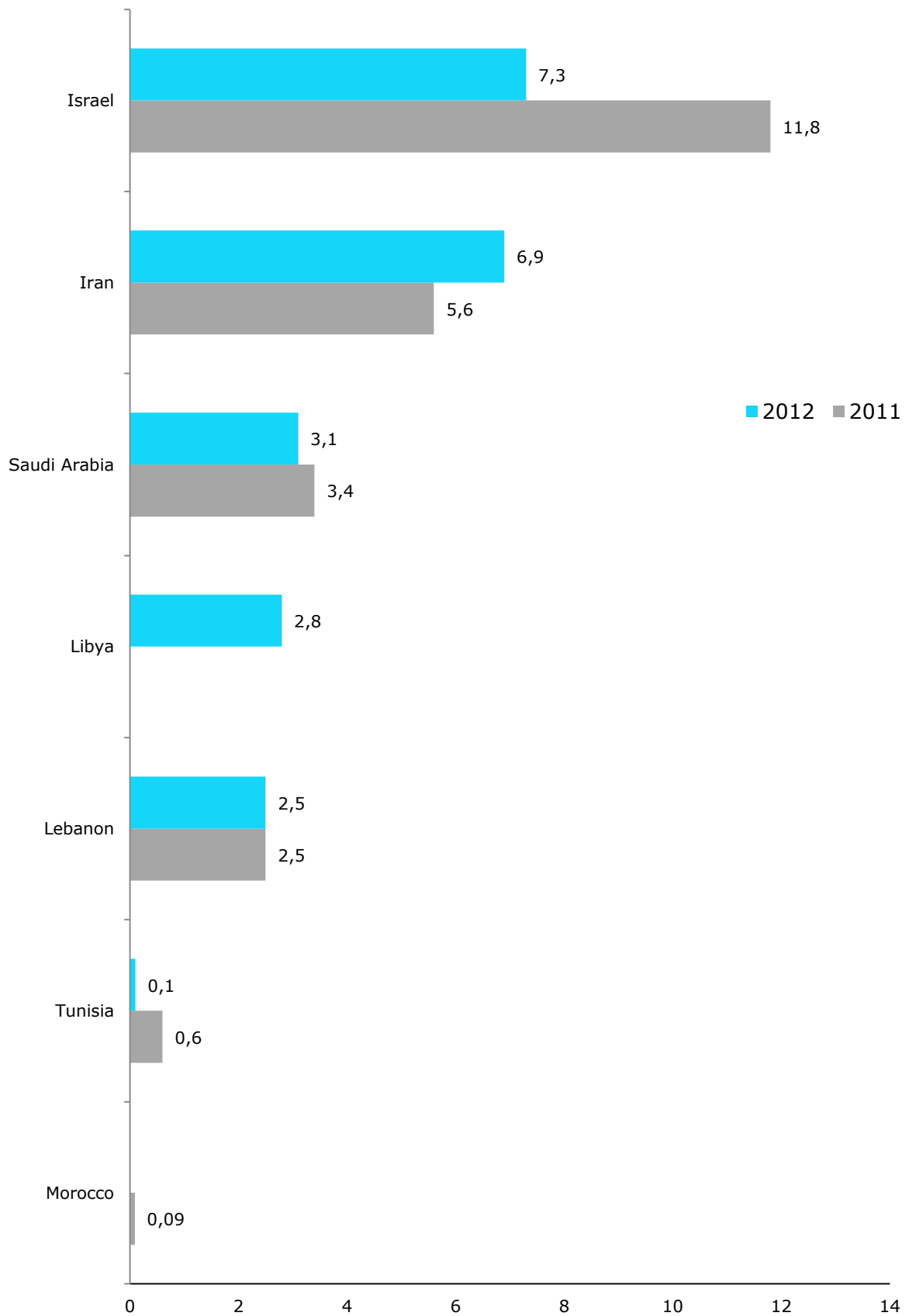
Asia - Oceania Actual Deceased Organ Donors (pmp)



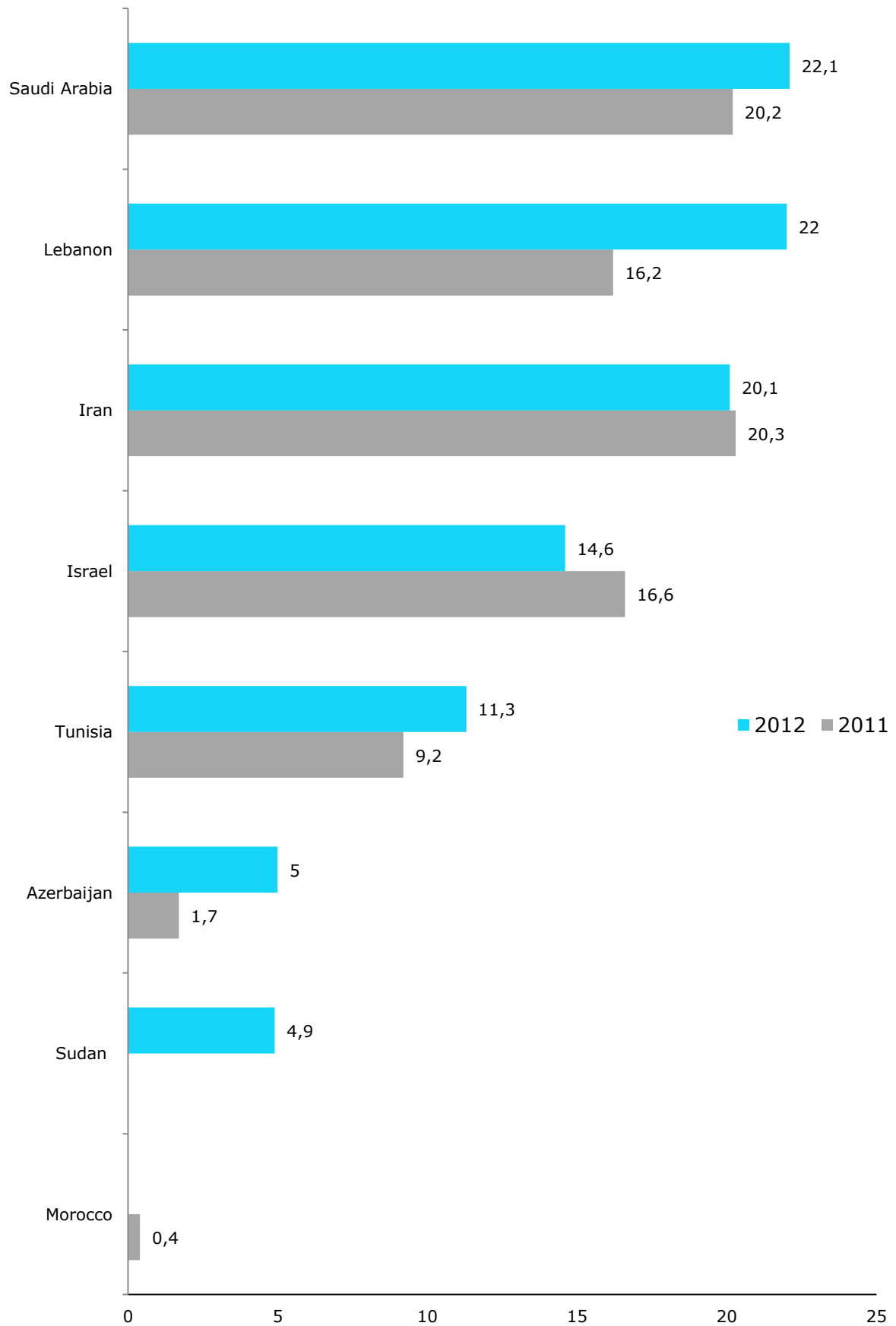
Asia - Oceania Living Organ Donors (pmp)

2. TRANSPLANTATION ACTIVITY

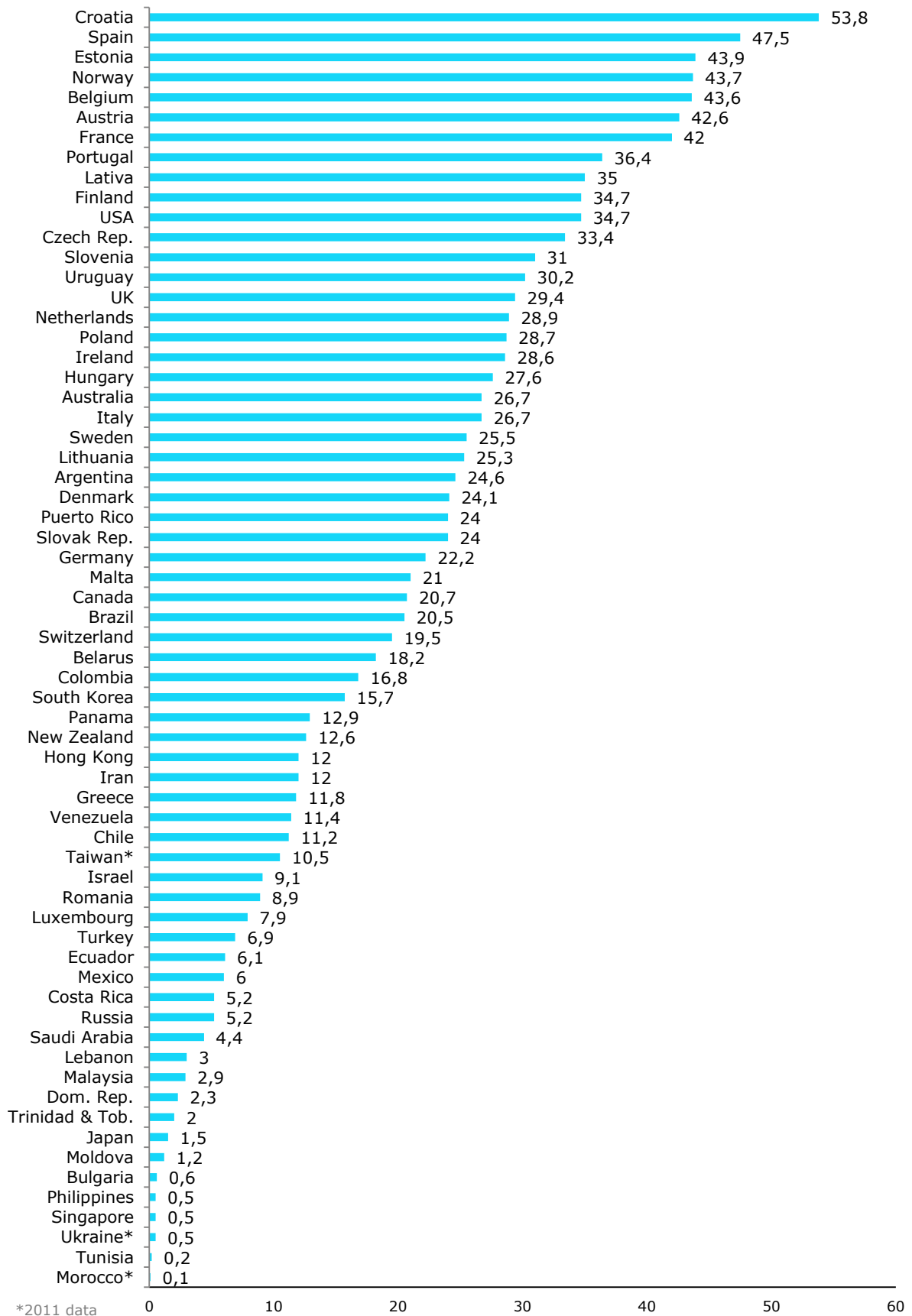

The case of kidney and liver organs are divided into two figures; one for transplant from deceased donors and the other for transplant from living donors.

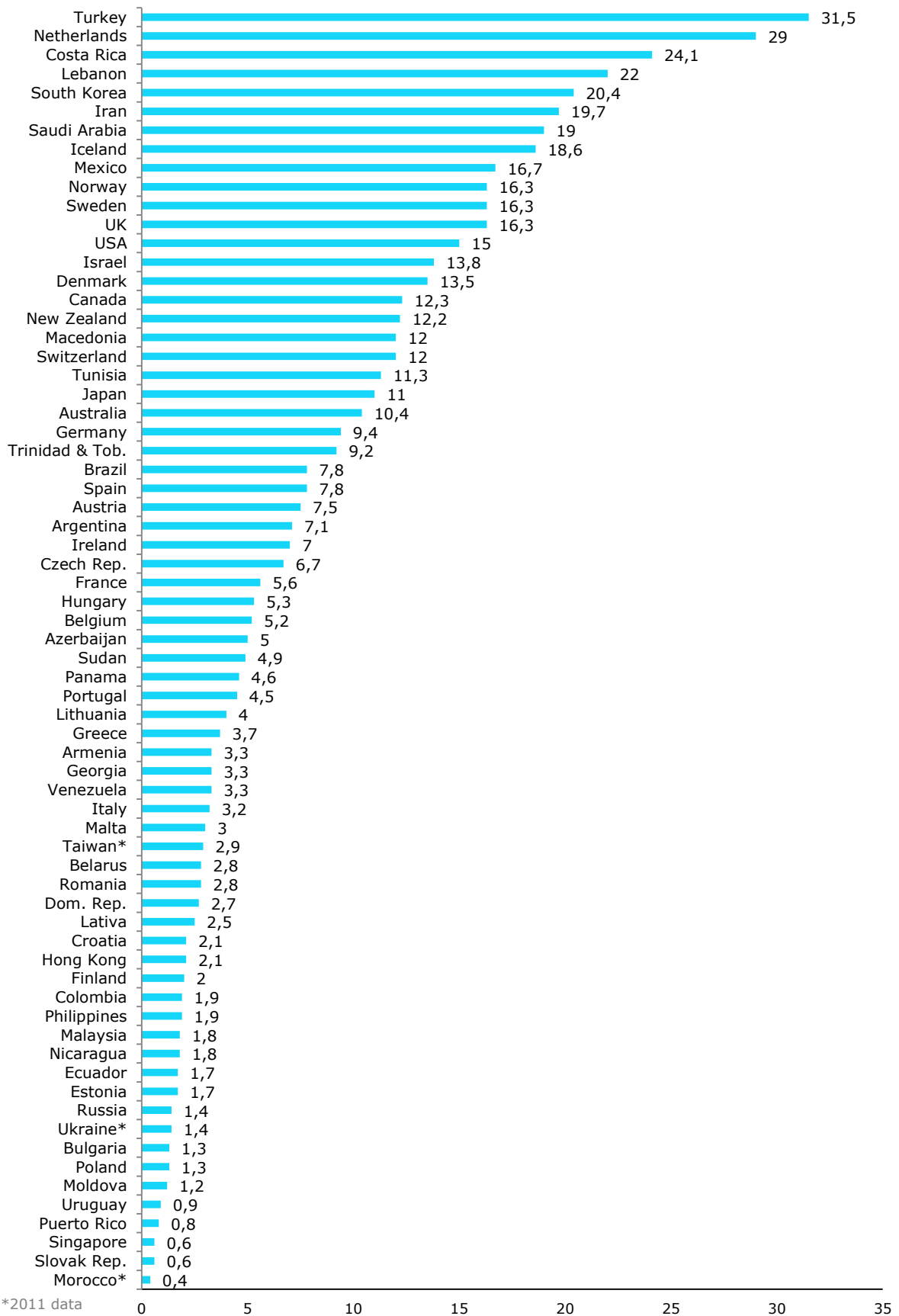
All graphs are represented in pmp, and the case of transplant from deceased donors' numbers had included all combinations.

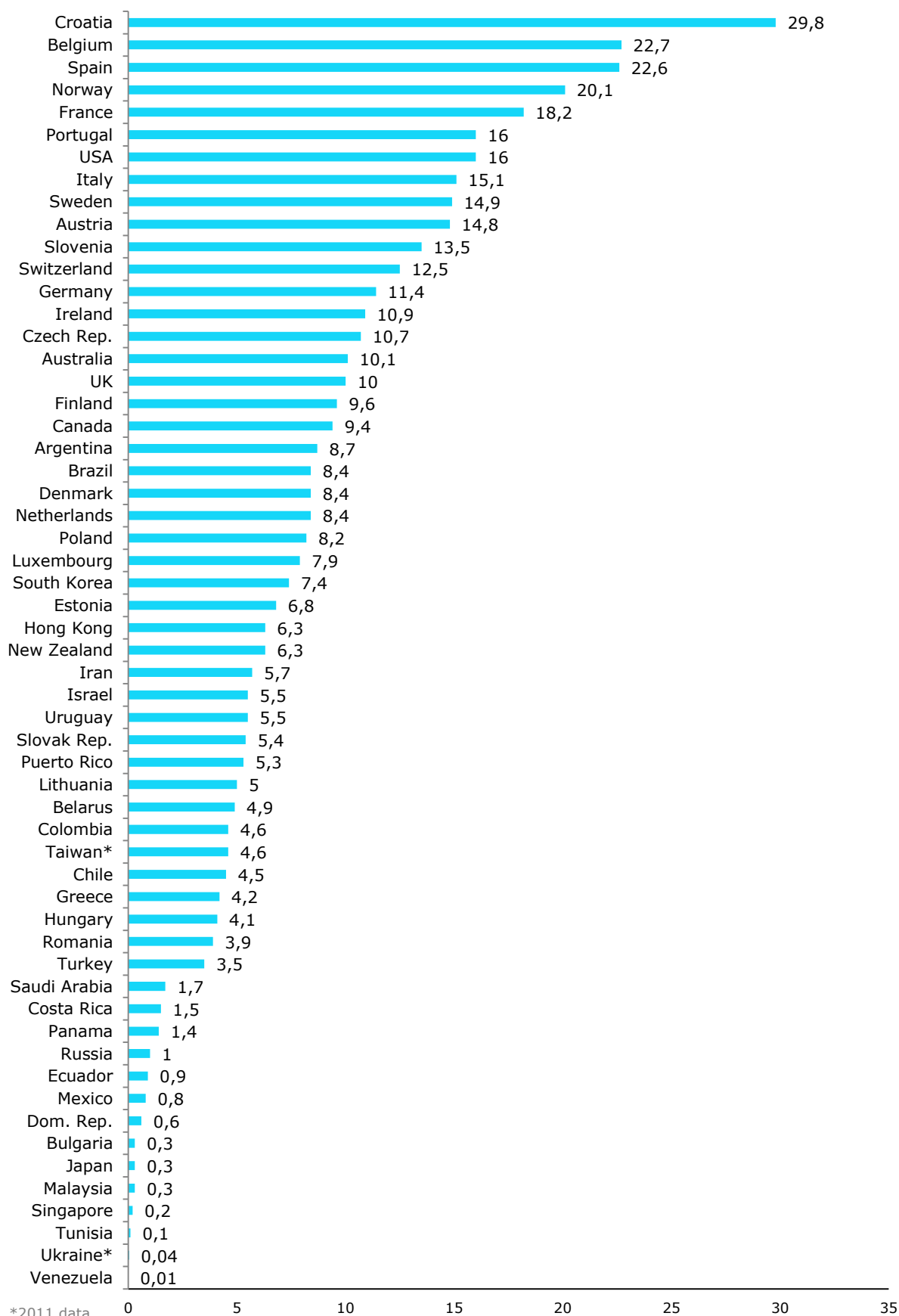
Worldwide Kidney Transplant from Deceased Donors (pmp)



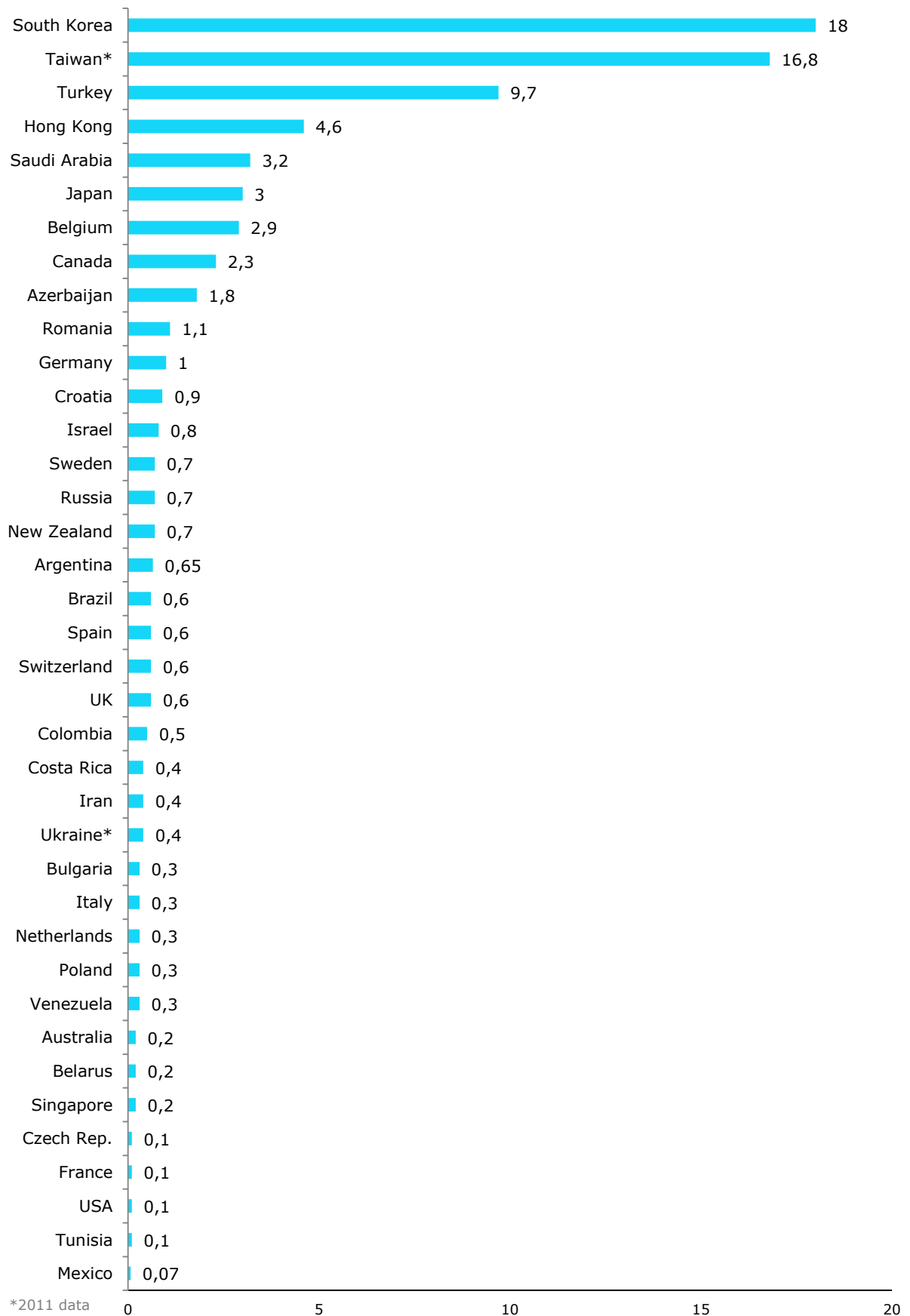
Worldwide Kidney Transplant from Living Donors (pmp)



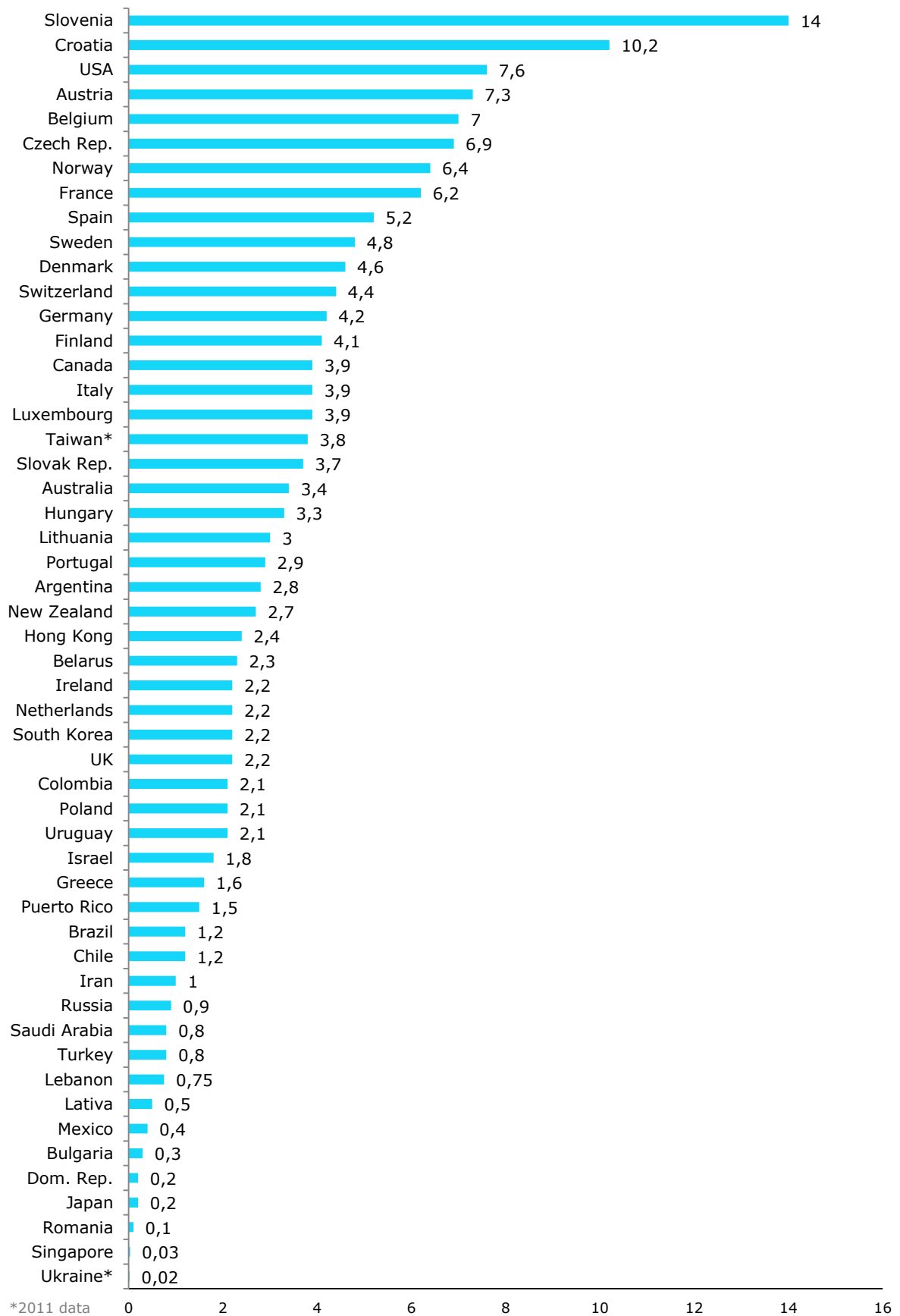
Worldwide Liver Transplant from Deceased Donors (pmp)



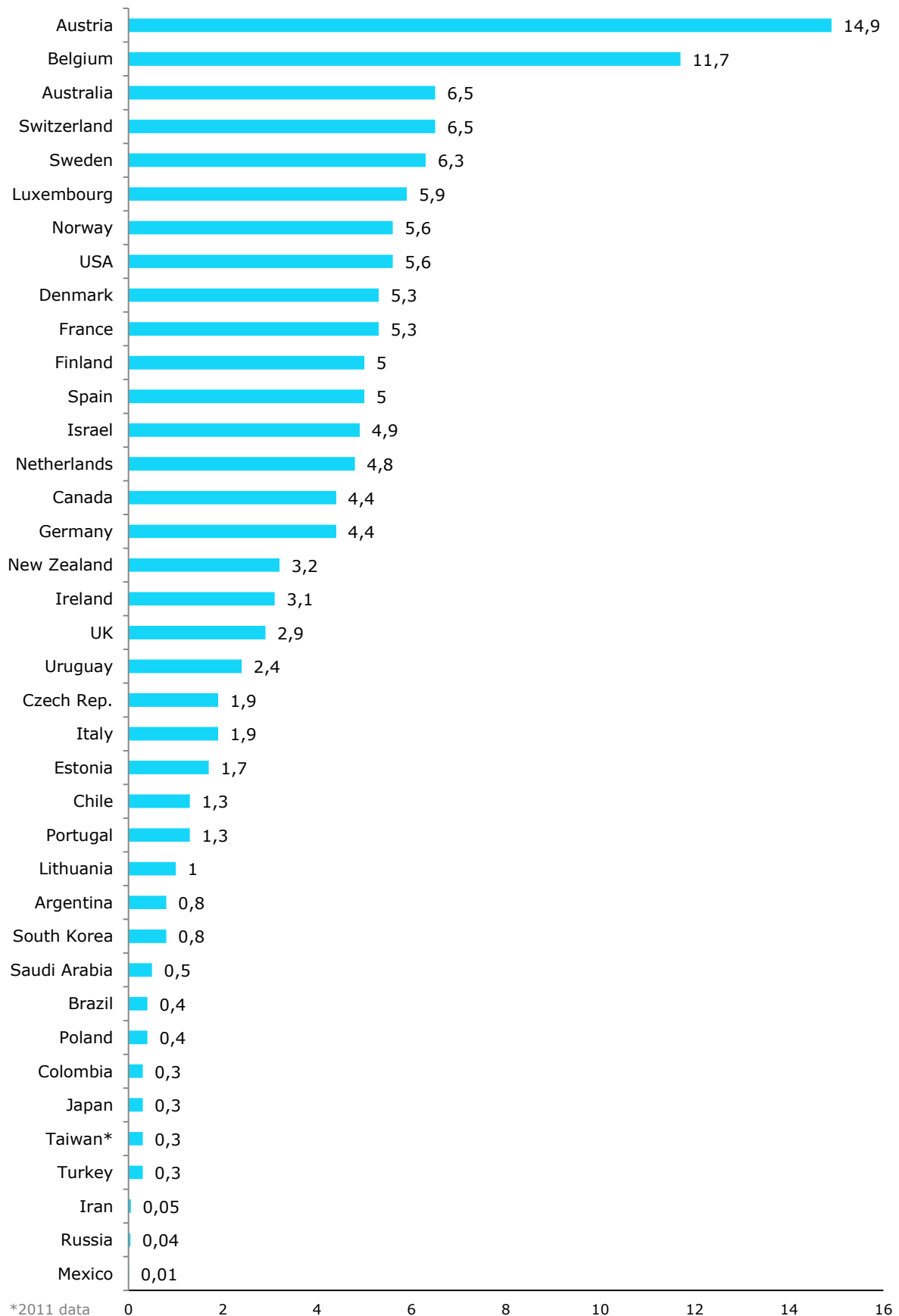
Worldwide Liver Transplant from Living Donors (pmp)



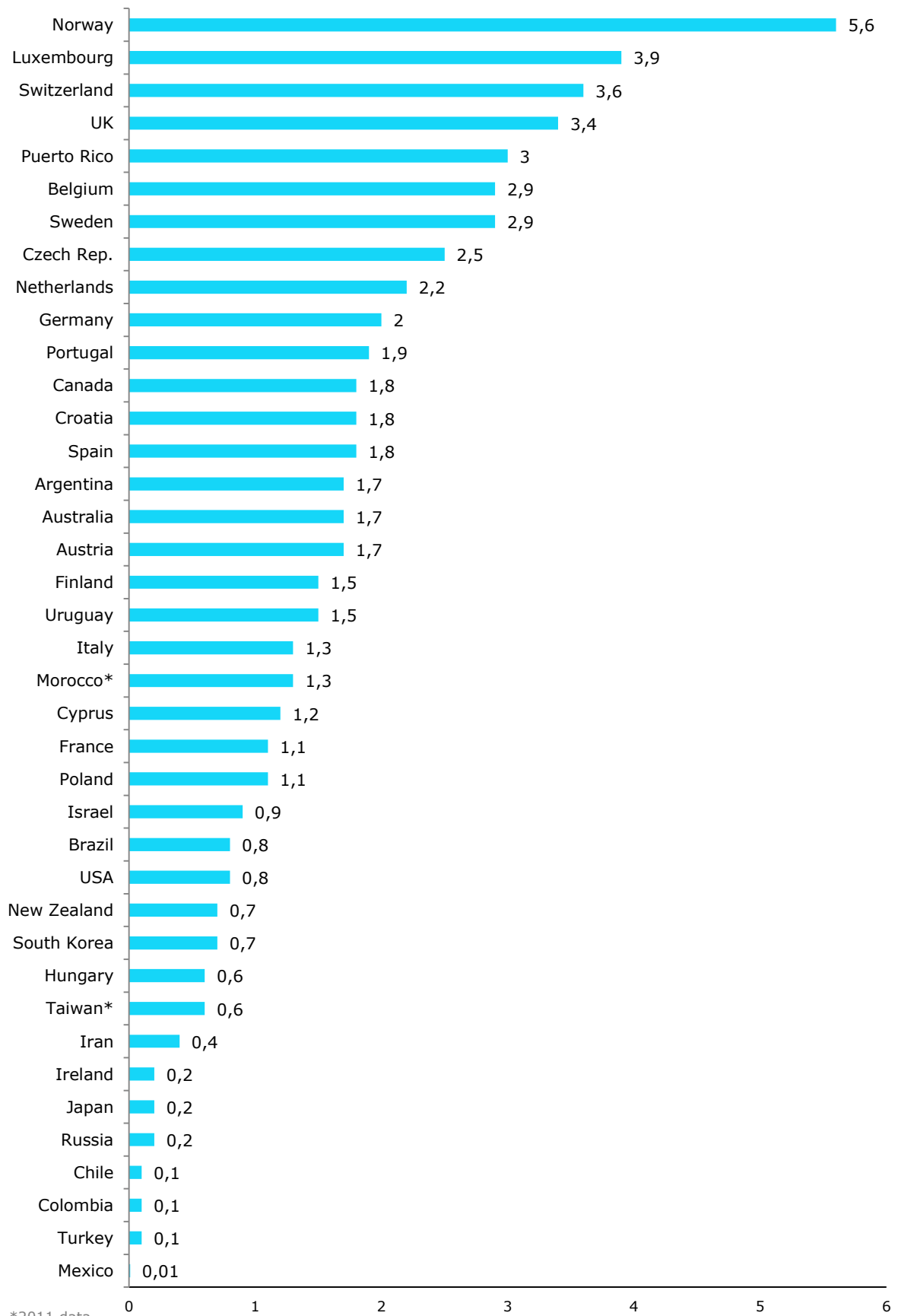
Worldwide Heart Transplant (pmp)
